This week for Language Arts homework, you will be writing a journal entry. The entry will need to be proofread, revised, edited, and then rewritten in your best cursive. You will need to have the person who proofread your "sloppy copy" (rough draft) write their signature. Please make sure you proofread your work first.

We have been learning about the Spanish missions that existed in Florida during the 1500's and the early 1700's. Your job is to pretend that you are a member of the San Luis de Talimali mission. You will write a journal entry highlighting what a typical day was like. You can write from the perspective of a Spaniard or a Native American. Some things you should include in your entry are: *What was the purpose of your mission? Who lives in your mission? How is your Catholic faith celebrated? What are your daily tasks? Does everyone get along?* Please make sure your information is based on our class discussions and readings.

Your writing will be evaluated using the criteria listed below:

- ___ response is thorough and well written, with varied sentence structure and vocabulary
- ___ very logically organized; contains introduction, development of main main ideas, and conclusion
- ___ correct capitalization, spelling, and punctuation are utilized
- ___ information is based on facts that have been learned in class
- ___ final copy is neatly written in cursive using blue/black ink
- ___ signature of adult who helped you proofread your work for content
