~Introduction~

The Diocese of St. Augustine Catholic Committee on Scouting introduced a new scout patch program, *"The Trail of Churches Pilgrimage"* in 2010. This project is geared toward promoting interest in the history, art and architecture of the Catholic Churches within the diocese. The purpose of *"The Trail of Churches Pilgrimage"* is to encourage Catholic scouts to learn more about their Catholic faith heritage and its rich traditions here in northeast Florida.

This booklet has been expanded in order to further encourage pilgrimages throughout the Diocese of St. Augustine during the 450th anniversary year.

Scouts who are interested in earning this patch will be asked to make a pilgrimage to different churches within the diocese. The criteria for earning the patch are:

✠ Visitation to seven pilgrimage churches which must include:

- Their own home parish*
- Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine
- Basilica of the Immaculate Conception
- Four other parishes of their own choosing

✠ Answer the questions provided in this booklet by visiting the seven parishes.

✠ Attend a Mass or other liturgy at each parish or spend an hour with the Lord in each parish.

✠ Write a short paragraph about your pilgrimage
